

LISTENING LIBRARY'S FANTASY ROAD TRIP CONTEST

Official Rules

I. HOW TO ENTER

Create a video of at least 30 seconds, but no longer than five minutes in length, answering the question “If you could go on a fantasy road trip with a character (or characters!) from one of these popular Listening Library series – Libba Bray’s *Gemma Doyle Trilogy*, Tamora Pierce’s *Beka Cooper* series or Rick Riordan’s *Olympians* series - where would you go? What would you do along the way? How would you travel?” Visit www.fantasyroadtrip.com and click on the link to post your video on Listening Library’s YouTube.com channel. To be eligible for this contest, you must register on youtube.com and provide a working email address so that we may notify you via youtube’s message service if you are the winner. Only videos posted on the specified youtube.com channel will be eligible to win. Additionally, any video that is less than 30 seconds and greater than five minutes in length will not be eligible. Limit one entry per person per author category listed above (i.e. *Gemma Doyle Trilogy*; *Beka Cooper* series; and *Olympians* series). All entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. Eastern Daylight Savings Time on August 17, 2009 to be considered. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.

Videos should creatively answer the contest question and **must include the following: (i) a reference to the state of Florida; (ii) a reference to audiobooks; and (iii) a clip of dialogue that can be downloaded from www.fantasyroadtrip.com website.** Any videos that contain profanity, violence or inappropriate conduct will be disqualified and removed from the Listening Library YouTube.com channel.

II. ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to all legal residents of the United States (excluding Puerto Rico) who are at least 13 years of age, but not older than 18 years of age as of June 1, 2009. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. Void wherever prohibited or restricted by law.
