Our “WRITE NOW!” workshops will whet your students’ appetites for the joy of creative expression, as well as bring them one step closer to some \$75,000 in scholarship awards.

The workshops are free of charge and hands on. **All we ask is that at least 12 students enter the competition per workshop booked.** Teaching artists share their work with students and then lead the class in an accessible and fun exercise that produces new writing then and there. In addition, sponsoring classroom teachers will receive a four lesson plan follow-up that will guide students to further develop and finish pieces for submission to the competition. The “WRITE NOW!” workshop is one period long and requires the attendance of at least 30 *seniors* and of course, YOU, the teacher. There is no upper limit on the amount of students as long as the space and monitors are appropriate to the size of the group. Workshops are scheduled on a first-come, first-serve basis and they fill up fast.
