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
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



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# First Into Nagasaki

The Censored Eyewitness Dispatches on Post-Atomic Japan and Its Prisoners of War

Censored in 1945 and lost for 60 years, First Into Nagasaki includes Pulitzer Prize-winner George Weller's legendary dispatches from post-atomic bomb Nagasaki and other never-published reports from Japan's POW camps.

n 1945, weeks after the atomic bomb struck Nagasaki, George Weller became the first outside observer to reach the devastated city, defying a news blackout. Disguised as a U.S. colonel, trying to discover what had happened, he initially sent stoic dispatches. But as he observed the effects of radiation, Weller's writing changed. He then entered nearby POW camps, gathering accounts from countless Allied prisoners, who, after years of torture, saw the bomb drop. General MacArthur was furious and censored the dispatches; Weller died believing them lost forever.

After his death, Weller's son found a fragile bundle of papers in a crate—the dispatches, never published, far more extensive than his father had remembered. Along with reports from the brutal POW camps, a stirring saga of the Japanese "hellships" that transported prisoners, and a trove of Weller's photos, *First Into Nagasaki* provides an unparalleled look at the bomb that killed more than 70,000 people and ended WW II.

GEORGE WELLER covered WW II for the Chicago Daily News and won many honors as a foreign correspondent, including a 1943 Pulitzer Prize for his reporting from the Pacific. He died at age 95 in 2002. ANTHONY WELLER, George's son, is a novelist and an award-winning journalist.

#### Nagasaki, Japan—Thursday, September 6, 1945—2300 hours

Walk in Nagasaki's streets and you walk in ruins.

It is twenty-eight days since two American planes appeared in a clear midday sky and let fall the blow which clinched Japan's defeat and decided her surrender. The mystery of the atomic bomb is still sealed. But the ruins are here in testimony that not only Nagasaki but the world was shaken.

The last two or three of what were scores of fires are burning amid Nagasaki's ruins tonight. They are burning the last human bodies on improvised ghats of rubbish. Flames flicker across flattened blocks from which planks, lathes and timbers have been removed as a fire menace, and only shapeless piles of plaster remain.

Yet the atmosphere is not precisely dolor-

ous. Nagasaki cannot be described as a city of the dead. The unquenchable Japanese will to live has asserted itself. Though the smashed streets are as barren of production or commerce as Pompeii's, yet a living stream of humanity pours along them, looking with alert, shoe-button eyes for today's main chance.

After a 24-hour trip on what seemed like dozens of trains, the writer arrived here this afternoon as the first visitor from the outside Allied world. The first thing you learn as you walk amid the flattened houses, and the cordwood that was once walls piled with Japanese neatness, is that the atomic bomb never really "hit" Japan. If the Japanese are right, the bomb exploded over Japanese soil. They can only tell what they saw and try to guess much of what really happened.

At about 11:30 o'clock on the morning of August 9th, a lieutenant who is aide to Major General Tanikoetjie, commanding the district, was walking through the headquarters on the hill above Nagasaki's long waterfront. The lieutenant heard a high faint moan of aircraft motors, found his fieldglasses, went to a porch and trained them to the sky. What

he saw was two B-29s at about 22,000 feet, flying in echelon. No anti-aircraft fire was around them; they were too high for Nagasaki's batteries.


Suddenly there broke from the forward plane three parachutes. Their canopies unfolded and what they bore earthward seemed to be three oblong boxes. The boxes looked about thirty inches long by eight inches wide. Demurely as *The Mikado's* three little maids from school, the canopies sailed downward. The lieutenant took them for some new form of pamphlet propaganda.

The three parachutes had reached the point where the lieutenant could begin sending auto crews to confiscate their freight when something violent happened. With the parachutes at perhaps a five thousand feet level there suddenly occurred below them, at about fifteen hundred feet, a burst of flame. Almost instantly the flame, yellow as gaslight, fell in a widening cone to earth, at the same time spreading wider in hoopskirt fashion.

This skirt of flame fell across the bottleneck creek which is a dead end for Nagasaki's tremendous shipping industry. Nothing human or animal that was above ground there at that moment survived.

As the fiery skirts swept the ground there suddenly burst upward a cumulus cloud of black dust. This cloud climbed high into the sky, visited by a terrible atomic heat erecting a pillar of warning over death's city. The lieutenant saw this as it began but immediately fell flat on his face, letting the concussion pass over him. When he rose up the parachutes were gone, and Nagasaki was afire.

Dr. Crippen almost succeeds in the perfect murder, but when his wife's body is discovered by a Scotland Yard inspector, he and his mistress flee the country on an ocean liner, followed by the inspector on a second liner. Only through the magic of Marconi's new technology are the pair captured.

Thunderstruck is also a vibrant portrait of an era presided over by a British king who loved to eat, drink, and make merry during the slow, inevitable descent toward World War I. And there are a host of fascinating characters populating the London of séances, science, and fog: the handsome Scotland Yard inspector who honed his skills on the Jack the Ripper case, a magician hell-bent on embarrassing Marconi, a sea captain turned detective, and many others.



A little while later, I looked at the clock and saw it was 2:30 in the morning. I remembered I had to go move my car to the other side of the street because of alternate-side-of-the-street parking regulations for street cleaning. Those cars not moved were towed. Plus, this was New York City. If you tried to stop them from towing you, they'd shoot you and leave you in the street as a warning to others. "Hey, I left this girl tied up because I had to move my car. Will you let me back in so I can go finish killing her and robbing her place? And maybe I can do you later this afternoon."

Finally, after a couple of hours, I just started

Plenty of people in other apartments heard me calling for her. I could here these old people yelling from behind their doors, "Who's out there? What do you want?"

The thought never occurred to me that, even if I did beat the odds and find the woman's apartment, there was no chance of her opening the door...because I left her tied to her bed.



Fishing. Old books about fishing. Wait—Moby Dick! Yes! Moby Dick!

On the videotape, you can see my hand begin writing.

Hold on. Wait. You can't fly-fish Moby Dick. My hand stops.





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

She plunged further, a diminishing dot of herself, then vanished into the secrecy of the valley below, never to be seen again. Why she chose to sing her death song this early in her life, I would only come to know later. For now, I was left dangling, as dangling as one could be.

But fate intervened once more. Grace



descended upon me in the shape of a scrawny village medicine man, old and faithful. When he heard me crying and saw me caught on the wind blasted cliff, he climbed down to fetch me as a monkey would. Fortunately, he was as nimble as one, for his vocation dictated that he roam the mountain ranges from peak to peak, from valley to valley and cave to cave in search of the rare ginseng and scarce swallows' spit only to be found in the capricious spots reached by birds.

He flung himself down, breaking through tree branches, missing a few footholds, nearly dashing himself to death. But on that given day heaven allowed only one death. Breathlessly he got hold of me. That was the moment I call my second birth, one given me by the grace of Buddha through the hand of one who had done his virtuous deeds day and night, caring for a village full of sick and poor. I say Buddha's grace and it was rightly so, for had another man heard me and, Buddha willing, found his heart wanting to save the little bundle, whether he was a virtuous man or not, he might never have done what the medicine man did, for in the old man's heart rang a lonesome bell of childlessness. The cry I made, the cry he heard, as he would later recount, was that cry deep in the recesses of his soul. It was not just a cry of any boy, but that of his own blood.

He was inches away when a blast of wind nearly took me away from it all again. But, one arm holding to a tree root, he reached for me, catching my tiny leg just in time to swing me into the crook of his arm. To save time, to save me, he did what no one dared do before, sliding hundreds of feet down the steep cliff, scraping his knees, his heels, nearly breaking his bones, then running home to his wife of forty years before the nocturnal mountain cats could smell our bloody trail.

The goat was chased and the milk milked. His wife fed me the milk as if it came from her own breasts. Then and there they named me Shento, the mountaintop, the zenith.


"He will soar for the sky like our sacred Mount Balan," Baba said.

#### THE LIFE BEYOND

While writing this book on the afterlife, I kept being drawn back to stories that I had heard in India as a child. In these stories the abstract issues of death, immortality, and eternity acquired a human face as ordinary people confronted the fear and wonder of death. Parables are a powerful way to teach children, and many of the ones told to me have lasted all my life.

So I decided to weave the whole book around tales of the kind I heard at home, around the temples, and at school, hoping that the reader would be enticed by a world where heroes battle darkness in order to emerge into the light. In my favorite story the hero is a woman, Savitri, and the enemy she must defeat is Yama, the lord of death. Yama shows up in her front yard one day, waiting to take away her husband the moment he returns from his work as a woodcutter.


I had no trouble seeing these characters. I was frightened for Savitri and anxious to find out how her battle of wits with Death turned out. That world flowed into my own, so I want to take time here to tell the reader what death meant in India long ago, something far different from what it means in the West, where I live today.

What was most magical in the world of my childhood was transformation. Death was a

brief stopping point on an endless soul journey in which a peasant could become a king and vice versa. The possibility of infinite lifetimes extending forward and backward was totally captivating because each soul could travel up and down as well, touring hundreds of heavens and hells. It's typically Indian not to crave permanence, and certainly everything in nature experiences a change of form. The drop in the ocean becomes vapor, which forms part of a cloud and falls as rain to soak deep into the ground, where it flows upward into a spring, which becomes a stream then a river, and finally flows back to the ocean.

How can we say that the drop of water has died? In each state it's the same drop, just with a different expression. From an early age I knew that the idea that I had a fixed personality or a fixed place in space and time was a mirage. Every drop of water in my body could have been part of an ocean, cloud, river, or spring the day before. I still draw comfort from this fact when the bonds of daily life squeeze too tight.

In Western religions the hereafter has been traditionally thought of as a place existing in space and time. Heaven, hell, purgatory, or some domicile for the dead is a distant region above or below the material





world. In my childhood the hereafter wasn't a physical place but a state of awareness, a plane of existence. Among adults this might be defined as an expression of Spirit or consciousness. Nor was there one universe, unless you understood that there were millions of planes of existence in which the cosmos lives and moves and has its existence.

What is that to a child? It could be a million drops of water sprayed from a garden sprinkler in summer, sparkling in the sun, or a seemingly endless library of fairy tales and fables, each with its own fantastic domain of wishes and dreams. Separating those domains from the "real" world was a mistake I never made. The cosmos that you and I are experiencing right now, with its trees, plants, people, houses, cars, stars, and galaxies, is just molecules dancing to a particular tune, at a particular set of frequencies. Somewhere else in space-time there are different planes of existence. If I had asked my grandmother where heaven was, she would have pointed to the house we lived in, not only because it was a loving house, but because it made sense to her that more than one world could comfortably inhabit the same place.

By analogy, if you are listening to a concert orchestra, there may be a hundred instruments playing, each occupying the same place in space and time. You could listen to the symphony as a whole or, if you wish, put your attention on the music or vibration of each specific instrument. You could even separate out the individual notes of the different instruments. In the music many vibratory frequencies exist independently, yet the presence of one does not displace any of the others. If you had an ear that could only hear one frequency, you would miss out on the rest of the symphony and only hear one instrument out of the hundred-even if that one instrument happens to be an angel's harp.


If your ear could expand to hear more

notes but all in the same frequency range—violin, flute, and piccolo, say—you would miss all the other frequencies being played—99% of reality would be unavailable to you because you weren't tuned in except to a very narrow band of sound.

I didn't know it as a child, but when I walked around the crowded Delhi market where more humanity was packed into one bazaar than it was possible to imagine, the world I couldn't see was even more crowded. The air that I breathed contained voices, car noises, bird songs, radio waves, X-rays, and cosmic rays, in a near-infinite see of subatomic particles. The existence of multiple realities was calling out to me everywhere I turned.

Every frequency in nature exists in the same location simultaneously, and yet most of these are invisible to us. It's natural to fear what we can't see, so when death snatches a person out of sight, we react with fear. I wasn't immune to this. The death of a pet made me anxious and sad; the death of my beloved grandfather, which happened suddenly in the middle of the night, was devastating. My younger brother kept running around the house crying, "Where is he?" It would be years before I realized that the answer was "Here and everywhere."

Ultimately the question of "What happens after we die" comes down to "What happens after I die?" The issue becomes personal, emotional, and inescapable. If a devout Muslim landed in a Christian heaven, or vice versa, eternity wouldn't meet with his expectations. Whenever expectations don't match reality you are disappointed. I was fortunate as a boy because the simple scheme I was presented with—and which I've elaborated on in these pages—allows for every soul to find the home where it belongs. The afterlife I grew up with is open-ended, like life itself. The spiritual wisdom of that worldview has stuck with me for decades, and now I hope to give readers a sense of the freedom it imparts, here and in every world to come.

#### MANAGE TEETHING

BILL SEARS



Dr. Bill Sears is the author of more than 30 books on childcare.

Babies are born with a full set of twenty primary teeth, just inside the gums. The lower teeth typically appear before the uppers, and girls teethe slightly earlier than boys. Beginning around six months expect four new teeth every four months until, usually by two-and-a-half years, all the baby teeth show. Teeth come through gums at unusual angles and the spacing does not necessarily reflect how the permanent teeth will appear.

Sharp teeth pushing through sensitive gums do hurt. Here are the nuisances to expect and suggestions to comfort the budding teether.

#### MANAGE TEETHING

#### DROOLING

The saliva faucet will be turned on during teething time. Expect these drool nuisances:

- Drool rash. Baby skin and excessive drool don't mix well. Expect a red, raised, irritated rash around Baby's lips and chin. Place a drool-absorbing cotton diaper under Baby's chin or a towel under his mouth. Be sure Baby is lying on his back. Gently wipe excess drool off the skin with lukewarm water and pat dry (don't rub). Lubricate with a mild emollient.
- Drool diarrhea. Expect loose stools and a mild diaper rash during peak teething time. This self-clears as each teething burst subsides. Apply a barrier ointment to Baby's bottom.

#### FEVER AND IRRITABILITY

The inflammation caused by hard teeth pushing through soft tissue may produce a low fever (101° F) and the symptoms of someone in pain. Ask your pediatrician about using acetaminophen to relieve teething pain.

#### **BITING**

The budding teether longs for something or someone to gnaw on. Gum-soothing favorites are:

- Frozen teething rings
- An ice cube rubbed along Baby's gums
- Frozen popsicle, bagel, or banana
- Frozen washcloth

As always, supervise to prevent choking on any of these.

#### NIGHTWAKING


Growing teeth hurt at night so teething babies wake up a lot. With your doctor's blessing, offer a dose of acetaminophen before bedtime or, if baby is in severe pain, a one-time double dose. Repeat the dose four hours later if needed.

Here are some general ways to tell the difference between teething and another illness:

- 1. Babies don't act progressively sicker with teething. When in doubt, have your doctor check it out.
- 2. Teething mucus is clear and doesn't run out of the nose.
- 3. Teething rarely causes a fever higher than 101° F.
- 4. Teething may be confused with an earache. Ear pulling in babies is an unreliable sign. Ear infections are more painful when lying down and have accompanying signs of a cold.

Expect your baby to need more comforting during teething time. While exhausting for you both, this can be an opportunity for Baby to build trust in you as a comforter.







But when it comes to love, it's not up to us to decide. The minute we are bewitched by this bizarre condition we have no choice but to go along for the ride. Trying to figure out whether or not the lucky guy is worth the trouble is futile—Cupid never reveals his master plan.

## Why do I love him, you wonder? You love him because anyone whose presence makes you feel alive deserves your total devotion.

Love is the answer, they say. What no one tells you is that you are left wrestling with this question: What do I love most, the object of my rueful affection or the irrepressible euphoria that's mine as a result of some stultifying hormonal collusion? Through a veil of warm tears, life oftentimes looks improbably beautiful. A marvelous sense of doom is likely to interrupt our most woeful ruminations—even as we hanker and pine for someone whose absence we mourn.

There is a strange comfort in being able to feel fortunate in spite of the grief. Ah, to be vulnerable, and yet at the same time to be smart, funny, silly, tough, and insightful!

How could you be so insensitive before as not to behold the trivial splendor of ordinary things, you wonder? Whereas you used to be somewhat discontent with our fate, you now feel ridiculously lucky because you noticed, as if for the first time, the elegant tracery of ivy on a brick wall or the tiny blossoms of weeds pushing though cracks in the sidewalk.

And there is more in store for you as time goes by and you find solace in your melancholy: not only are you more likely now to see greatness in what you used to call mediocrity, you also discover the beauty of operatic music, turn up at poetry readings, find older men more attractive, are less critical of your mother's taste in clothes, develop a preference for Côtes du Rhône wines over Bordeaux, and reach out to friends whom you have neglected.

But you derive the greatest pleasure from knowing that you can now feel pain and yet give love in return.

- The sensuous organic silk Uma, created by Vicki Square






