- **Domino Cushion:** With its playful pattern, designed to look a bit like a jockey's silks, this cushion makes a strong statement in any room.

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- Gridlock Throw: the original geometric pattern for this throw was taken from an ancient carpet.

From innovative sweaters to creative cushions and colorful throws, **KAFFE KNITS AGAIN** is filled with wonderful patterns—and they’re not just for the expert knitter! Kaffe’s goal in this book is to inspire even the “nervous knitters” to try his designs. In fact, Kaffe transforms many of his original design motifs into easier projects, such as scarves and shawls, by working with simple knitted squares, stripes, or rectangles.

KAFFE KNITS AGAIN is Kaffe’s very welcome return to the knitting book community. If you are one of the millions of knitters who know and love Kaffe’s unique and intricate designs, or if you are seeking challenging colorwork pieces, then this is the book for you.
