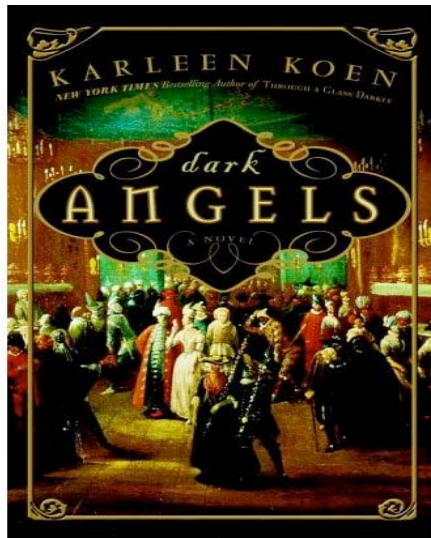

Her plan is to win the favor of the aging and highly regarded Duke of Balmoral, an act that will give her the status she desires. But first, she will need to survive the treacherous Royal Court of King Charles II, which is still struggling to overcome the financial woes from England’s recent civil war, the shame of a barren queen, and the risk of religious turmoil.

When a ruthless murderer -takes up residence in England, a whirlwind of suspicion -sweeps through the king's court, and no one is safe from the repercussions of threatening deeds. As a popular figure within the court and the only person who knows the murderer's past, Alice finds that she will need to rethink all of her old alliances, including the trust of her father, and use every ounce of cunning to protect the royal family – and herself – from harm. In the process, Alice uncovers much more than she ever suspected –rumblings of an impending war, whispers of succession battles, secret plots for betrayal of the country's top leaders, and a shocking call for the king's divorce from his Catholic queen. Enlisting the help of an honorable and charming member of the King's Life Guards, and a colorful array of characters along the way, Alice races to find the truth and risks everything – even her pride and possible status – in the process.

With exquisite detail and rich historical insight into England's Restoration period, **DARK ANGELS** transports readers to a world caught between long-held customs and modern conduct, prestige and passion, duty and love, and the ever-shifting loyalties of political circles, family ties, and class. Koen weaves an expertly imagined story filled with all the intrigue and glamour of the very best historical fiction.
