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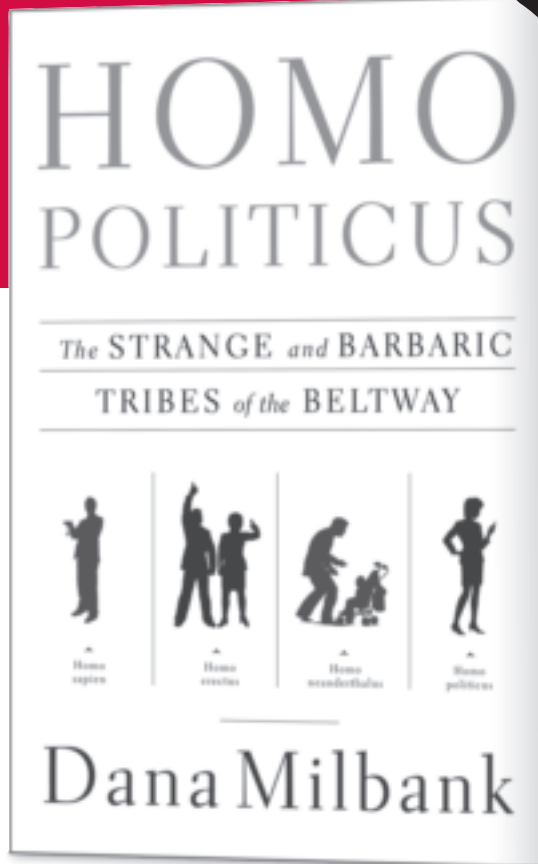

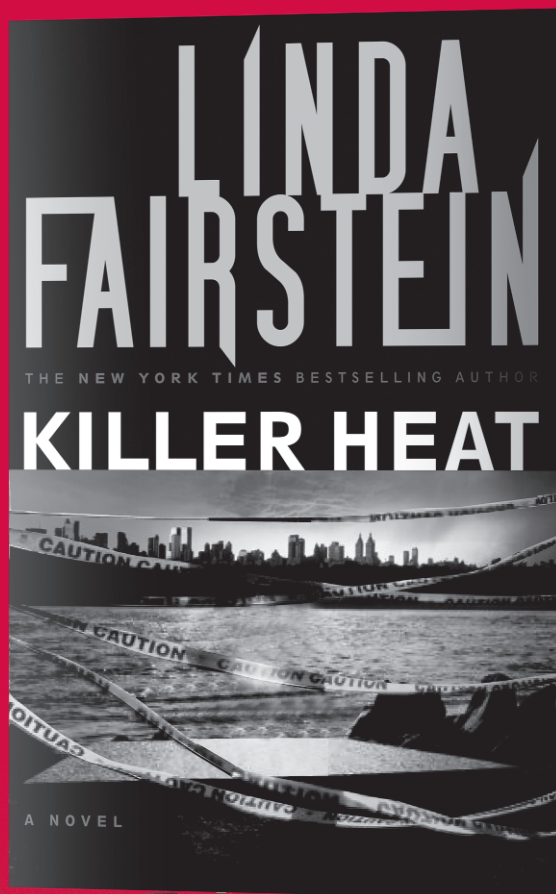

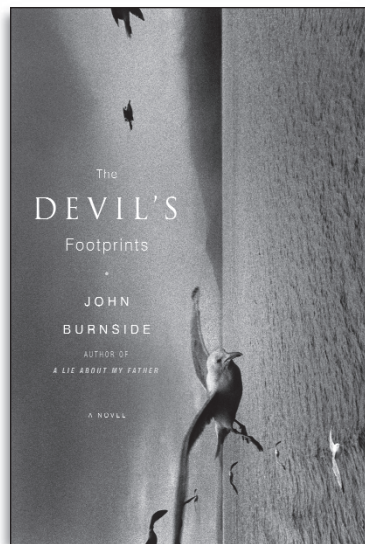

As teenagers, Michael and Moira had a brief romance; more troubling, Michael was responsible for the death of Moira's brother, the town bully. In the wake of the tragedy, Michael becomes obsessed with Hazel, who is just old enough to be his daughter. Aware of his obsession, Hazel convinces Michael to take her away from the village and her father. Their journey takes readers backward and forward in time, gradually uncovering the secrets of the past.

Set against the untamed Scottish landscape, *THE DEVIL'S FOOTPRINTS* explores the elemental forces of everyday life: love, fear, grief, and the hope of redemption. It is a novel of mysterious beauty, written with the clarity and power of a folktale.

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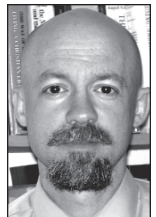
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Robert George and Christopher Tollefsen make a compelling scientific and moral case that human life begins at conception and that embryos are therefore entitled to the full protection of the law.

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Robert George and Christopher Tollefsen use recent research into fetal development to show that from the moment of conception, embryos are human beings endowed with all ensuing rights. Delving into classical ethics, they argue that there is no room for a “moral dualism” that denies fetuses basic human rights, and soundly reject the utilitarian worldview which might allow the killing of embryos for the “greater good” of society.

The Re-enslavement of Black Americans from the Civil War to World War II

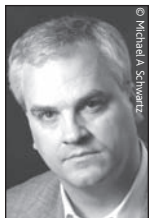

This devastating, well-documented history exposes for the first time the widespread enslavement of African American men that flourished throughout the South for decades after Emancipation.

In this groundbreaking book, Douglas A. Blackmon brings to light one of the most shameful chapters in American history.

From the late 1870s through the mid-twentieth century, under laws enacted specifically to intimidate blacks, thousands of African American men were arbitrarily arrested, hit with outrageous fines, and charged for room and board in state and county jails. With no means to pay these "debts," prisoners were required to work them off. Thousands of other African Americans were simply seized by landowners and forced into unpaid labor. In an iniquitous system, governments leased wrongly imprisoned blacks to small-town entrepreneurs, provincial farmers, and large corporations—including U.S. Steel—looking for cheap and abundant labor. In factories, mines, lumber camps, quarries, and on farms throughout the South, armies of "free" black men labored without compensation, were repeatedly bought and sold, and forced through extreme physical coercion to do the bidding of white masters. Revenues from neo-slavery poured into Southern state treasuries. The system was finally ended only in the 1940s, partly due to fears of enemy propaganda about American racial abuse at the beginning of World War II.

Based on a vast record of original documents and personal narratives, *SLAVERY BY ANOTHER NAME* is a moving, sobering account of a little-known crime against African Americans, and the insidious legacy of white racism that reverberates today.

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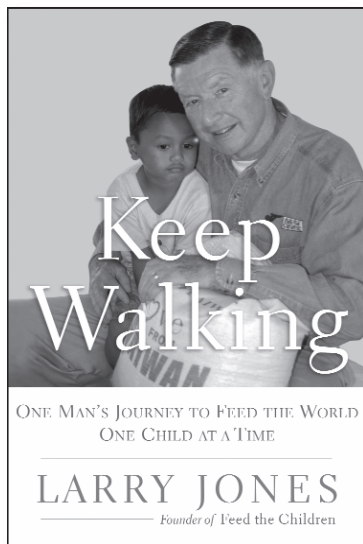
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In an uplifting memoir, the founder of Feed The Children tells the story of his organization and its remarkable, life-affirming work both here and abroad.

In 1979, Larry Jones was ministering in Haiti where he was approached by a young boy who hadn't eaten all day. The child asked for a nickel to buy a roll. Recalling the wheat surplus back home in Oklahoma, Jones soon started Feed The Children, initially a wheat-exporting outreach that grew into one of the world's largest and most respected charities. Year after year, it efficiently distributes food and other essentials to impoverished families throughout the United States and much of the rest of the world.

In *KEEP WALKING*, Jones describes his journey from a childhood as the son of two barbers in America's heartland to a career that takes him to war-torn countries and areas devastated by natural disasters—as well as into the halls of Congress and the offices of foreign governments to solicit support and funding. How to Find Your Divine Purpose When Life Is Not Turning Out Like You Wanted

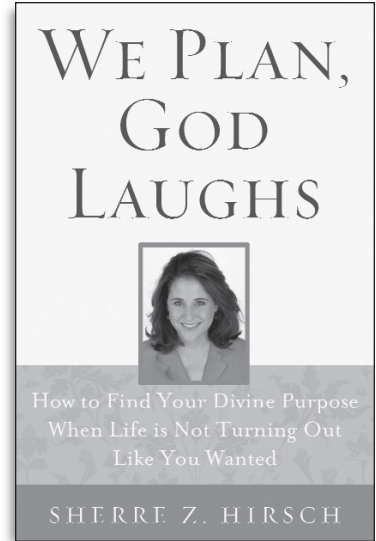
In the tradition of *When Bad Things Happen to Good People*, a smart, compassionate teacher looks at a timeless question and offers a powerful, life-changing response.

The old Yiddish proverb, "We Plan, God Laughs," expresses a truth everyone can relate to. At every stage of life we make plans, setting out where we want to go and imagining what we will be like when we have "arrived." But things have a way of turning out not quite as we hoped or expected.

In *WE PLAN, GOD LAUGHS*, Sherre Hirsch argues that too often our plans are limited to ones we think up at bedtime, or are devised by our parents, or by what looks good on a résumé. Addressing serious spiritual issues, Hirsch explains how to formulate a plan that reflects who we are now and who we want to be—a plan that is alive, organic, and in sync with God.

Hirsch teaches the importance of letting go and recognizing that even the most ordinary life is extraordinary in the eyes of God. She makes no foolish promise that life will turn out as we plan, but shows that with hope, faith, and belief, we can change our lives for the better and make a positive difference in the lives of others.

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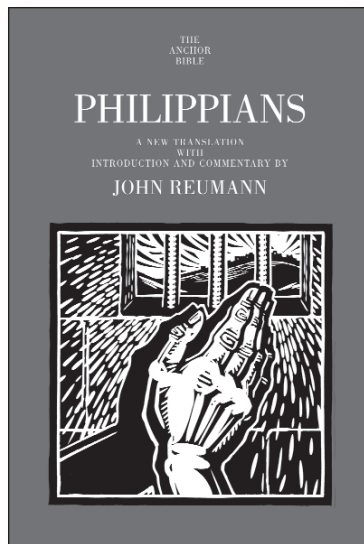
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A masterful study of one of Paul's most complex, interesting, and uplifting letters.

Paul's Epistle to the church at Philippi has long stood out as his most joyful letter. It is addressed to his favorite congregation, the converts who were his most devoted followers. At a time when Paul lacked the support of most of the other churches he founded, the Christians at Philippi sent him financial gifts and even an "apostle" of their own, Epaphroditus, to aid him in his mission and comfort him during his imprisonment. In appreciation, Paul offered them praise and support, encouraging them to pursue a creative theology (in 2:6-11) and to seek greater maturity in their faith in the face of considerable civic opposition and threats from Hellenistic ideologies.

For centuries, Philippians was thought to be a single letter written by Paul when he was imprisoned in Rome. In recent years, however, Reumann and other scholars have come to the consensus that it is actually three separate letters, two of which were written from a prison in Ephesus. Reumann discusses in the introduction why he reached this conclusion, and goes on to provide a translation and commentary that will stand as the definitive study of this important Epistle for decades to come.

JOHN REUMANN teaches at the Lutheran Theological Seminary in Philadelphia, where he is Ministerium of Pennsylvania Professor Emeritus of New Testament and has served as dean and acting president. He is the cofounder of the Philadelphia Seminar on Christian Origins.

On February 12, 2005, Dorothy Stang, a seventy-three-year-old nun, was murdered in cold blood. This is the powerful story of her work, her life, and her legacy.

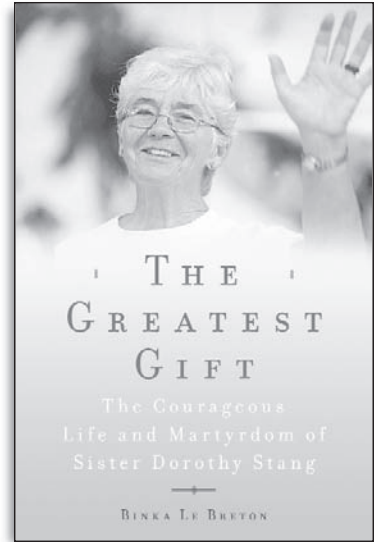
In 1966, Sister Dorothy Stang went to Brazil as a missionary, and in 1982 she moved to a small town in the Amazon to work with an organization to protect poor farmers and their land from loggers and land-developers who stop at nothing—including murder—in pursuit of profits. After testifying at a government panel investigating illegal incursions into protected areas, Sister Dorothy was renounced as a “terrorist” by powerful companies and began receiving death threats. Refusing to be intimidated, she continued her work—until two gunmen shot her six times on a rural Amazon road.

THE GREATEST GIFT is the first biography of this extraordinary woman and her mission. Written by a mainstream journalist who has spent many years in Brazil, it exposes the entrenched collusion between government officials and commercial interests, and celebrates the profound courage of Sister Dorothy and others fighting to protect the Amazon jungles and the people eking out a life there.

Inspired by deep religious conviction, Dorothy Stang gave of herself generously. A book that will resonate with readers of Sister Helen Prejean’s *Dead Man Walking*, THE GREATEST GIFT presents not only the story of Sister Dorothy’s tragic death, but the powerful and beautiful lessons of her life.

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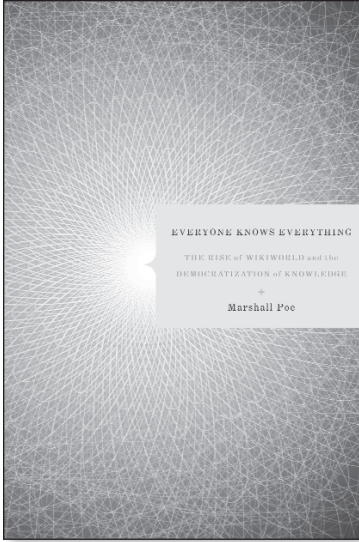
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EVERYONE KNOWS EVERYTHING

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In this fascinating look at mass collaboration on the Internet, Marshall Poe takes us on an incredible trip that begins with the origins of human society and ends with the emergence of “WikiWorld,” the universal sphere in which billions of people create, trade, and transform all the information there is. According to Poe, the collaborative instincts driving Web phenomena such as Wikipedia, MySpace, and YouTube are ancient, but they have been transformed by the democratizing technology and culture of the Internet. The Web liberated the innate human impulse to “lend a hand” and to “pitch in” for the first time in history. MARSHALL POE is a professor, writer, and consultant. After earning his Ph.D. at the University of California, Berkeley, he taught for a decade at Harvard University. He was then a writer and editor at *The Atlantic Monthly*, where he focused on the Internet. He is currently an associate professor of history at the University of Iowa.

She is not alone, as all the other women in the Welsh border valley of Olchon wake to find their husbands gone. With these sudden and unexplained absences, the women regroup as an isolated, all-female community and wait.

Later, a German patrol arrives in the valley, the purpose of their mission a mystery. When a severe winter forces the two groups together, a fragile mutual dependency develops. Sarah begins a faltering acquaintance with the patrol's commanding officer, Albrecht Wolfram, and it is to her that he reveals the purpose of his mission. But as the pressure of the war beyond presses in on this isolated community, its fragile state of harmony is increasingly threatened.

Imbued with immense imaginative breadth and confidence, Owen Sheers's debut novel unfolds with the pace and intensity of a thriller. A hymn to the glorious landscape of the Welsh border territories and a portrait of a community under siege, *RESISTANCE* is a first novel of considerable grace and power.
