


# Jerry Spinelli

# About the Author

rowing up, Jerry Spinelli was only serious about baseball, but in high school, he traded in his baseball bat for a pencil. He knew he wanted to be a writer. After graduating from Gettysburg College, Mr. Spinelli worked full time as a magazine editor, writing novels during his lunch hour. He wrote his first four books for adults and all were rejected by publishers. His fifth book, about a 13-year-old boy, was embraced by children's publishers, so he feels he accidentally became a children's book author.

Jerry Spinelli's books are often hilarious and thrilling, while also emotional and true.

Mr. Spinelli lives with his wife and fellow writer, Eileen, in West Chester, Pennsylvania. While they write in separate rooms of the house, the couple edits and celebrates one another's work. Their six children have given Jerry Spinelli a plethora of clever material for his writing.
