Storytime with Duck & Goose



BEFORE STARTING THE STORY

Hold up a copy of *Duck & Goose* and ask the children at your story hour about the cover. Tease to the story with questions like "Do you know what kinds of birds these are?" and "Do Duck and Goose look happy in this picture?" Tell the children that the first story you are going to read is all about sharing and ask the kids to raise their hands and tell you what it means to share something. Then say, "This is the story of two best friends, Duck and Goose. They weren't always best friends, though! They needed to learn to share first! Then they realized they'd have more fun together than they would alone."

AS YOU READ

Ask engaging questions about the story, such as "What do you think is inside the egg?" or "Duck and Goose are having a hard time sharing. What do you think they should do?"

END THE STORY

Ask the children to raise their hands and tell you the name of one of their friends. Then see if they can remember a time they shared something with their friend. Once you're done hearing from the audience, ask if everyone would like to hear about Duck and Goose's favorite colors and read them *Duck & Goose: Colors!*









Goose Mask


Look like Goose! With the help of an adult, cut out the mask below and color it in! Punch holes on either side of the mask and attach elastic or string tied to size.



Help Goose find the way back to Duck through the maze! Start at the inchworm (can you find him on the leafy branch?) and finish by the butterfly!






Help Duck & Goose learn their colors!
