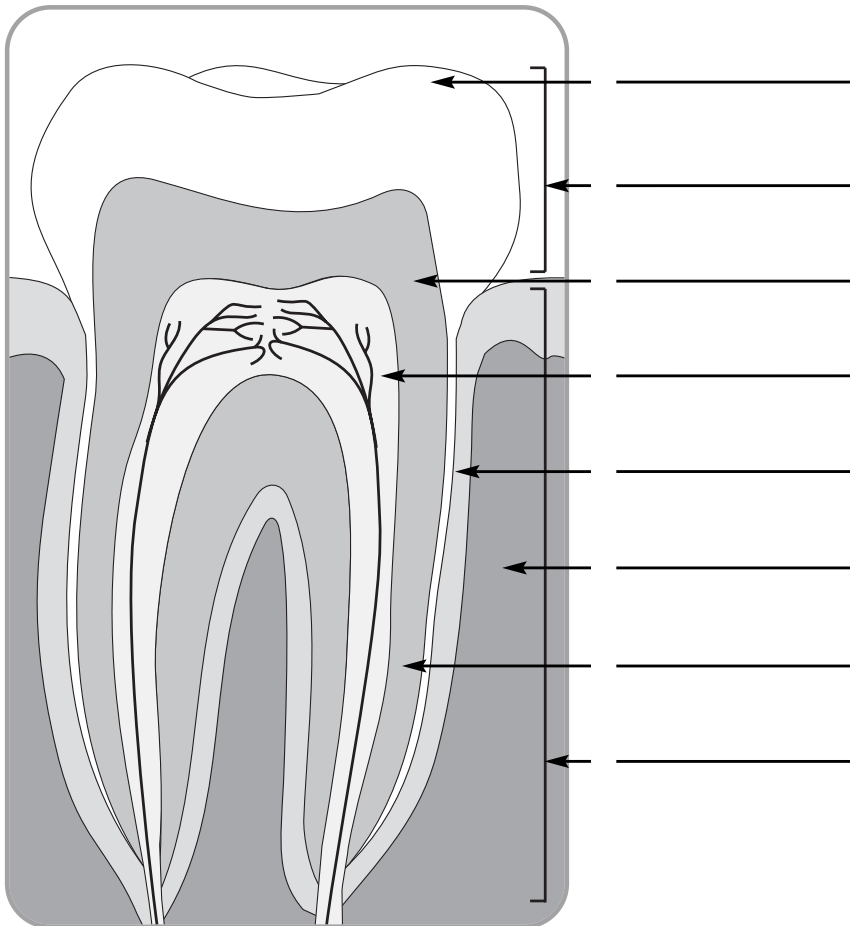

Gum

The soft tissue that surrounds the base of the tooth

Root

Part of the tooth that grows under the gums and holds it in place

Bone

Hard tissue in which tooth's root is anchored

Nerves and Blood Vessels

Transmit signals and carry nutrients to the tooth

Pulp

The soft center of the tooth where the nerves and blood vessels live

Dentin

The softer tissue under the enamel that can decay

Enamel

The hard, white outer covering of the tooth

Crown

The part of the tooth you can see
