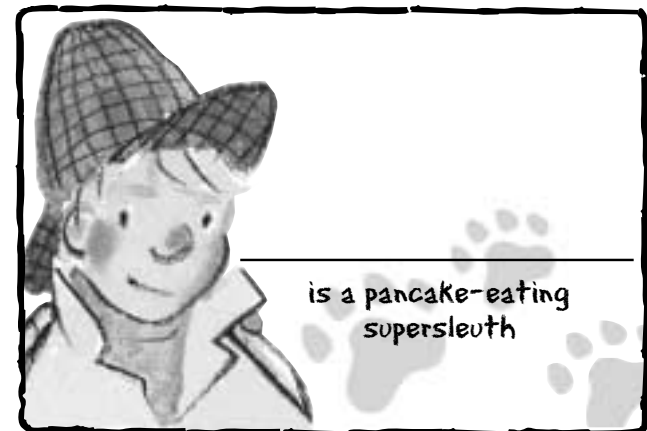


MAKE YOUR OWN NATE THE GREAT MAGNIFYING GLASS

Color your magnifying glass and carefully cut it out. Write your name in the center of the glass. Decorate your classroom and then you're ready to solve some mysteries!



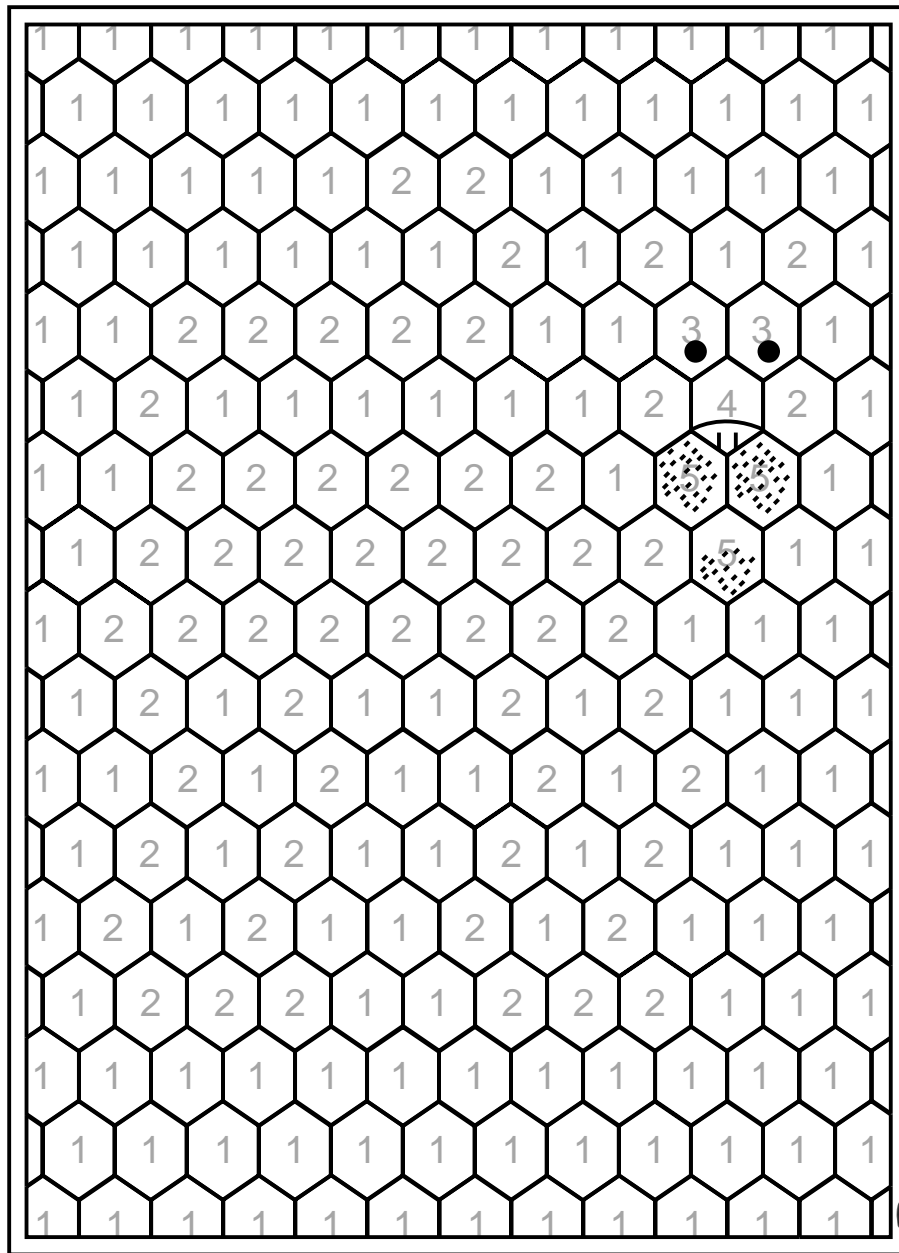

Help Nate Figure Out Which Pet Is Missing

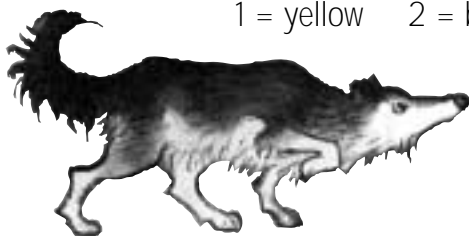

To solve this puzzle, color in the spaces as follows:

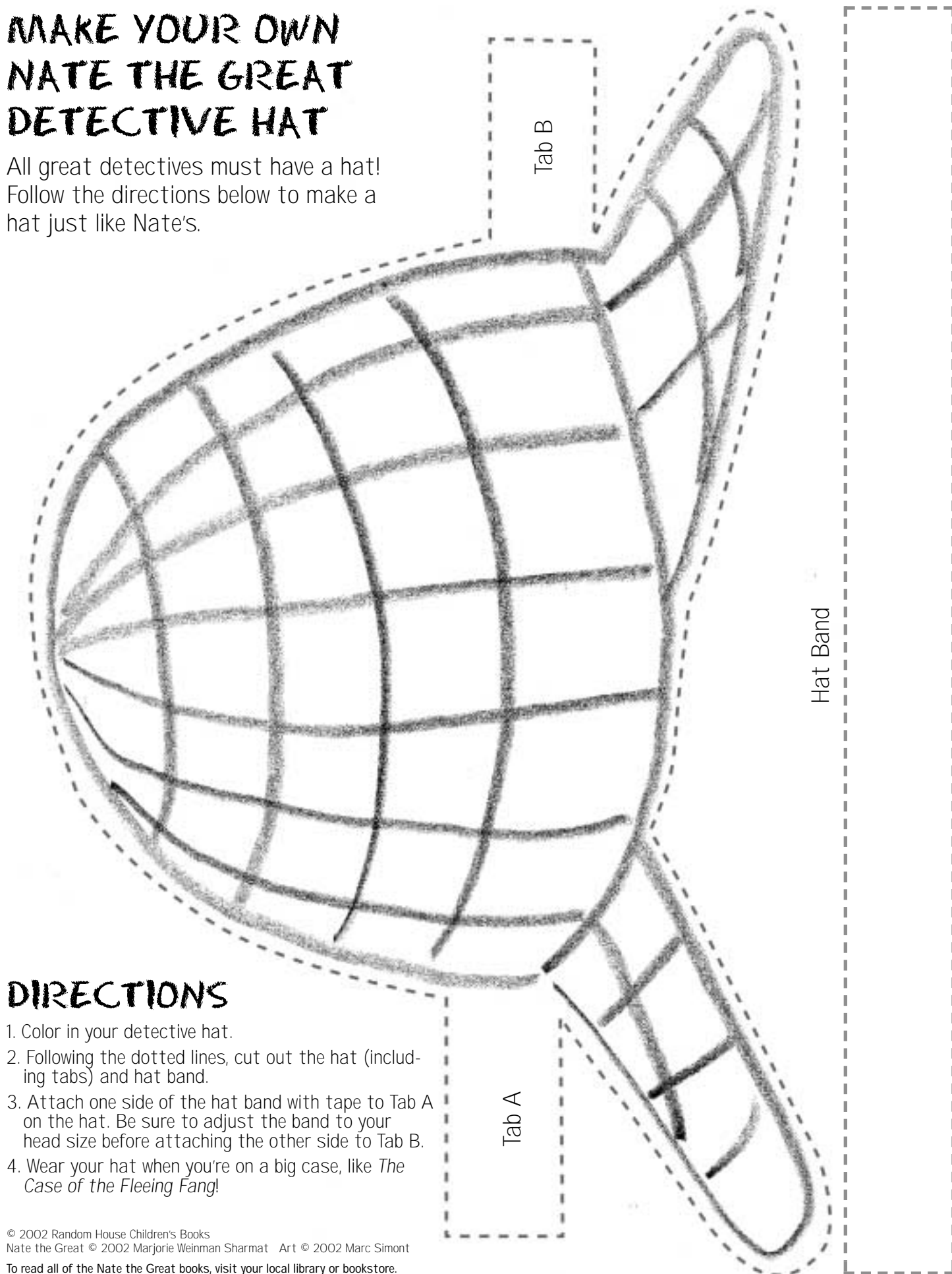

hat just like Nate's.



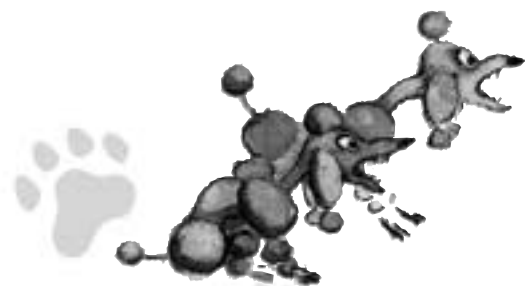
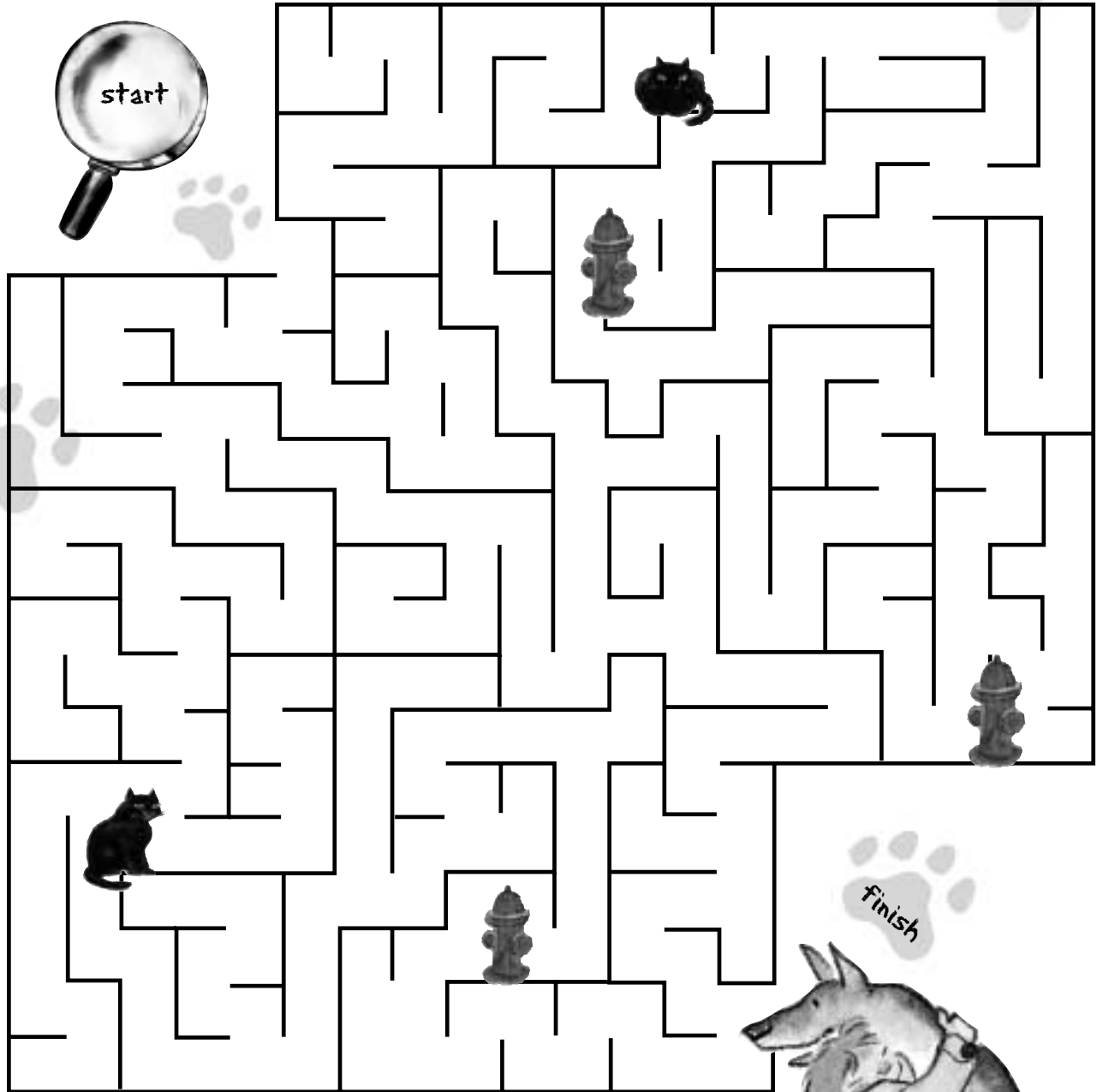
DIRECTIONS

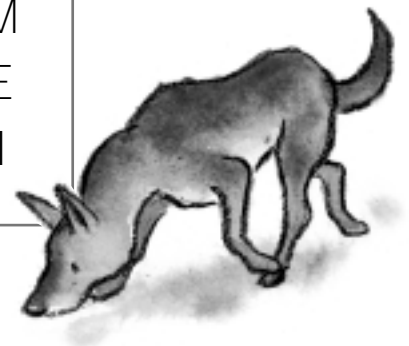
Help Nate and Sludge find Annie's dog, Fang. After you find him, you can color the maze.



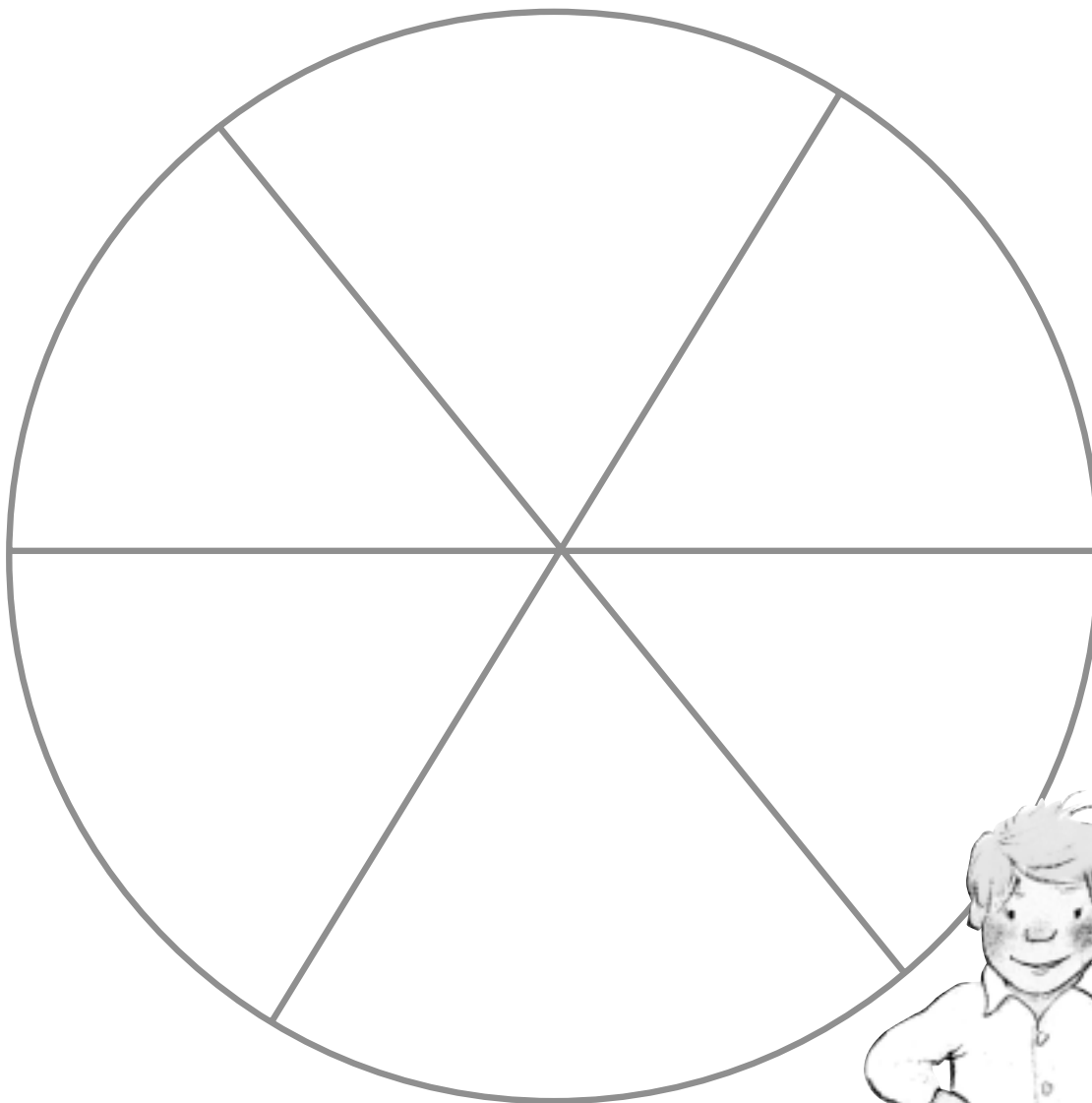
